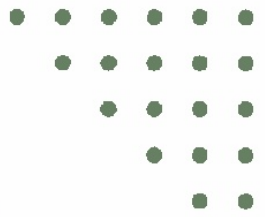

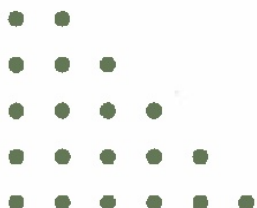

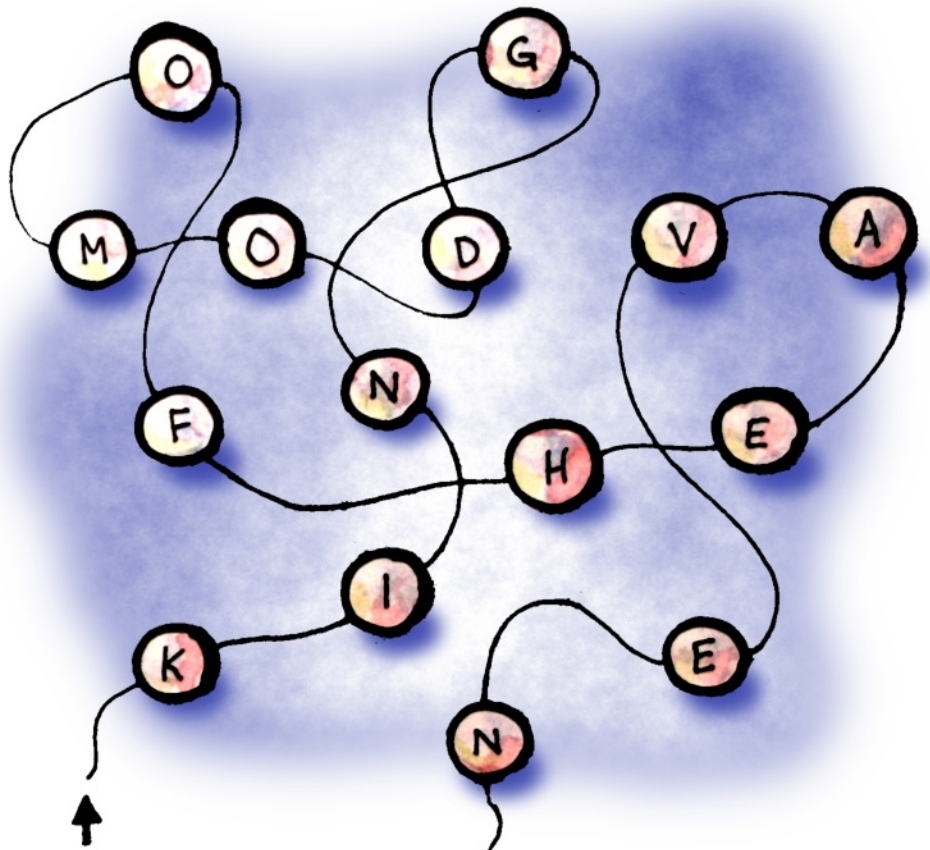

Saint Alphonsus Liguori

August 1

ALPHONSUS LIGUORI WAS BORN TO A CATHOLIC FAMILY IN ITALY IN 1696. HE WAS VERY INTELLIGENT AND BECAME A LAWYER BY THE TIME HE WAS 19.

WHEN HE WAS 26 HE MADE A MISTAKE IN A CASE, AND REALIZING THE PETTINESS OF LAW HE DECIDED TO QUIT.

WHILE VISITING THE SICK HE RECEIVED A VISION THAT INFLUENCED HIM TO BECOME A PRIEST.

AT FIRST HIS FATHER RESISTED, BUT HE FINALLY AGREED IF ALPHONSUS WOULD LIVE AT HOME.

SO ALPHONSUS DID MISSIONARY WORK FROM HIS HOME.

HE BEGAN TWO RELIGIOUS ORDERS AND WAS MADE A BISHOP TO A FALLEN-AWAY AREA.

HE PREACHED AND WROTE IN SPITE OF HAVING RHEUMATISM AND PARALYSIS. HE SUFFERED MANY HARDSHIPS WITH THE FOUNDING OF THE ORDERS TOO.

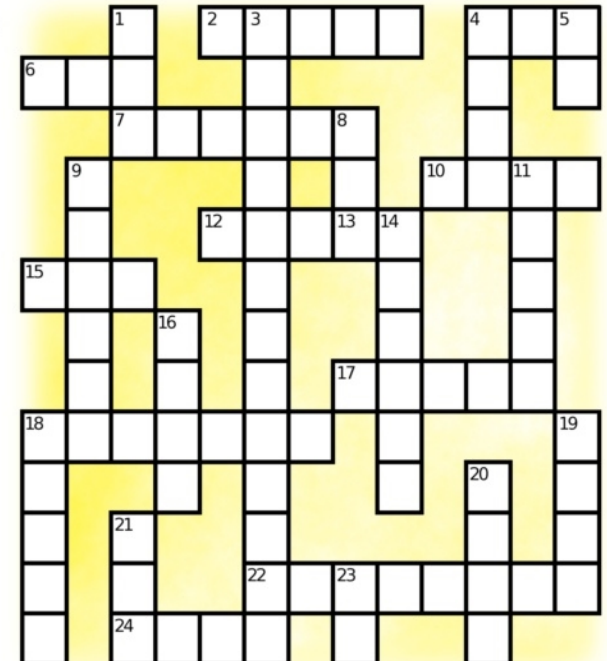
