The Church encourages individuals to make holy resolutions and to continually strive for holiness throughout their lives.

The Church teaches that the faithful should participate in the Eucharistic celebration on Sundays and holy days of obligation, which includes the commemoration of the Resurrection of the Lord. This regular participation in the Mass provides an opportunity for spiritual renewal and growth. Additionally, the Church emphasizes the importance of the sacrament of reconciliation, which involves confessing one's sins at least once a year. This sacrament allows for the forgiveness of sins and prepares individuals for the reception of the Eucharist. Furthermore, the Church encourages the faithful to receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season. This practice ensures that individuals receive the Body and Blood of Christ, which is central to the Christian liturgy.

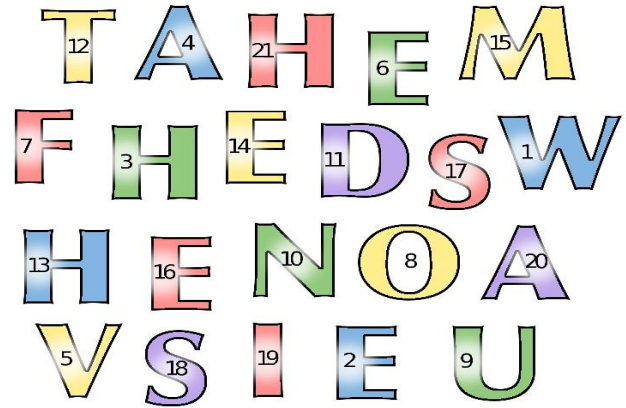

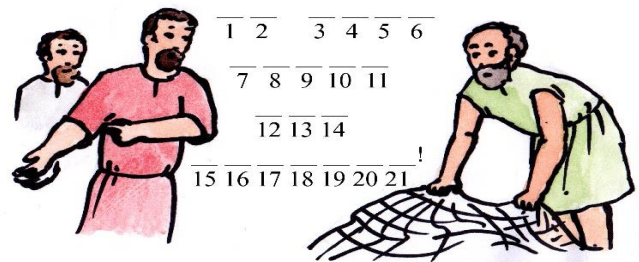
