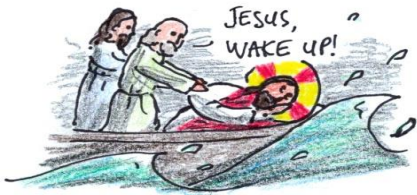

If ever you feel scared, pray to Jesus right away. He can help to calm your fear, and He can help you to make good decisions. God is always there for us, even when things seem hopeless!



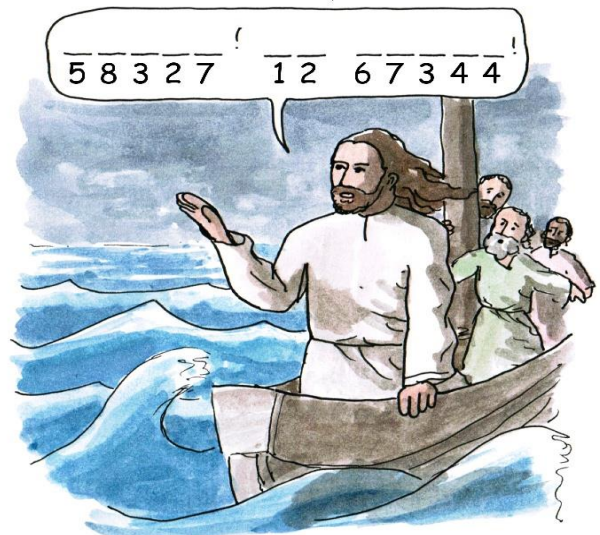

## Saint Josemaria Escriva June 26

JOSEMARIA WAS BORN IN SPAIN IN 1902 TO A DEVOUT FAMILY. WHEN HE WAS A TEENAGER HE REALIZED THAT GOD HAD A PLAN FOR HIM.

Bare feet in this cold! I must be able to offer something to God too!

HE BECAME A PRIEST AND ALSO STUDIED THE LAW.

WHEN HE WAS 26, ST. JOSEMARIA STARTED OPUS DEI, WHICH MEANS WORK OF GOD.

God wants everyone to be holy, not just priests.

The everyday work you do is participating in God's creation.

OPUS DEI IS AN ORGANIZATION THAT HELPS LAYPEOPLE BE HOLY IN THE WORLD.

DURING THE SPANISH CIVIL WAR MANY PRIESTS WERE KILLED, BUT FR. JOSEMARIA SURVIVED.

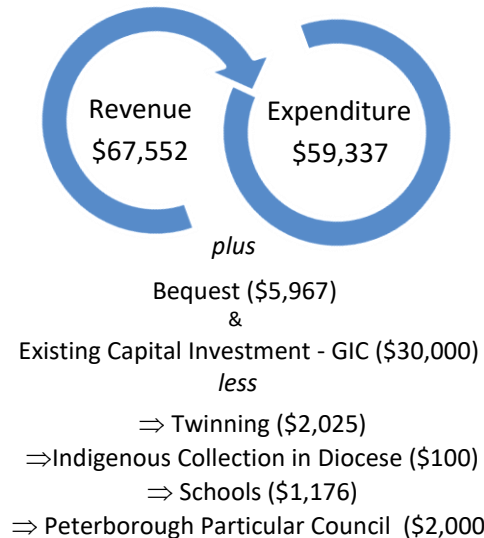
