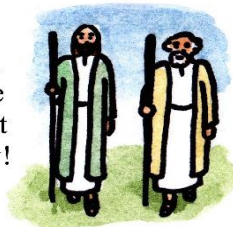

Now I know that there is nothing more important than the True Faith.

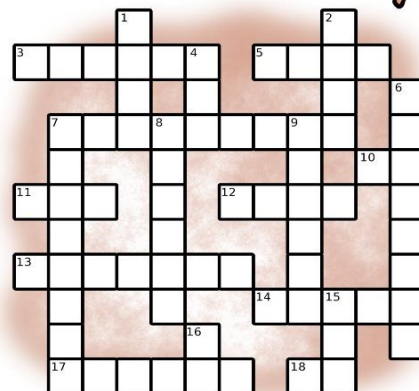
