When five thousand people came to hear Jesus, He turned one boy's bread and fish into enough for everyone. How much did He have to start with? Colour and count the loaves and fishes with crosses on them to find out!

When Jesus saw that a large CROWD was coming to him, he said to PHILIP, "Where can we BUY enough food for them to eat?" He said this to TEST him, because he knew what he was going to do. Sacraments
