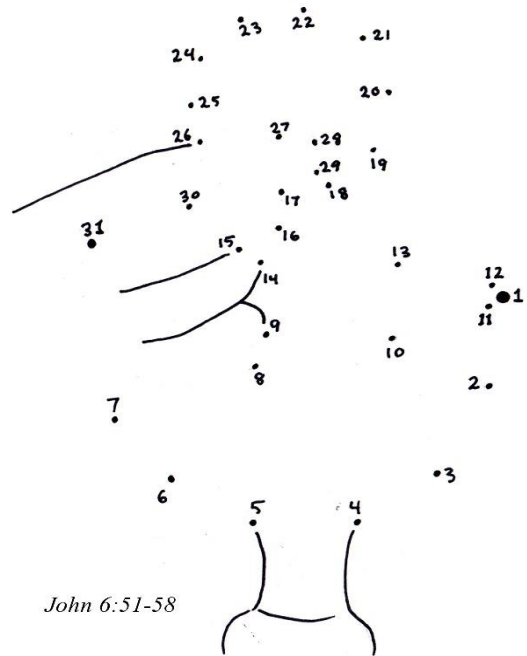

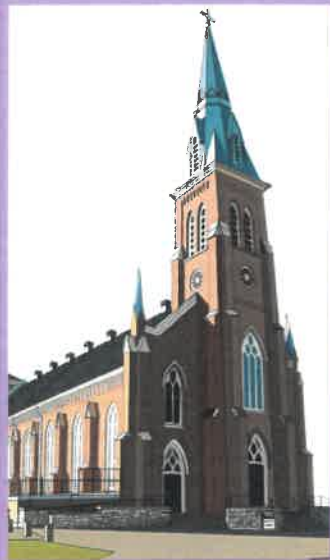

Anointing of the Sick: If you have a family member or know someone near death please call the rectory and request the sacrament of the sick.
