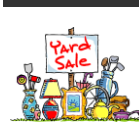

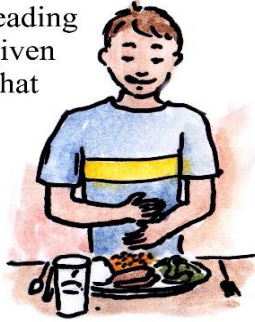
DEPARTING THE DIOCESE

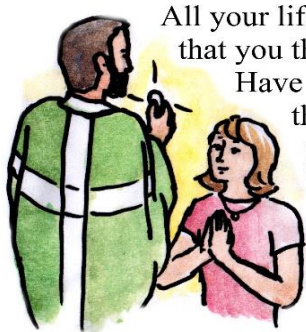

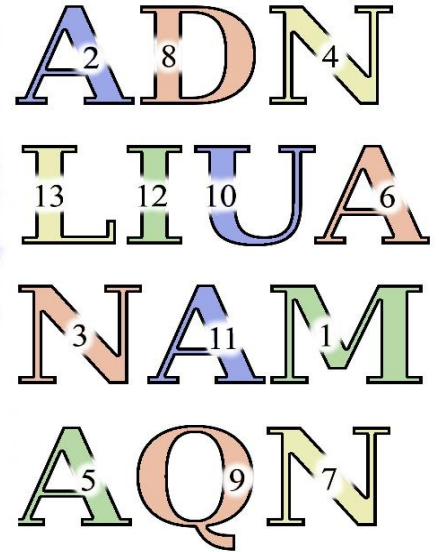

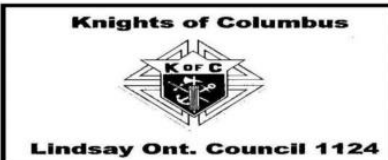
