Sure! Thanks!


Always act kindly toward others. Treat everyone in the way that you would want to be treated. Show that you are a follower of Jesus by how you love others!



CATERINA DE PAZZI WAS BORN TO A NOBLE FAMILY IN ITALY IN 1566. SHE WAS BAPTIZED AND TRAINED TO BE A GOOD CATHOLIC.



AT AGE 9 SHE WAS TAUGHT BY A PRIEST TO MEDITATE - TO PRAY SILENTLY AND THINK OF GOD. "Take thirty minutes every day to talk with God."



SHE RECEIVED HER FIRST COMMUNION AT AGE 10, WHICH WAS EARLY IN THOSE DAYS.



FOR TWO YEARS CATERINA WENT TO A CONVENT SCHOOL.



THEN SHE ENTERED THE CONVENT AT AGE 16, TAKING THE NAME MARY MAGDALENE. "She's so sick - let her make her vows early, before she dies."



SHE RECEIVED MANY VISIONS OF OUR LORD AND THE SAINTS. OTHER NUNS WROTE WHAT SHE SAID DURING THEM.



"It is all madness! God doesn't care what you do!" "No! I must keep on and trust God!"

SISTER MARY MAGDALENE RECOVERED AND WORKED WELL IN THE CONVENT. HOWEVER, FOR FIVE YEARS SHE HAD GREAT TRIALS AND TEMPTATIONS.

MARY MAGDALENE DE PAZZI RECEIVED MANY VISIONS FROM GOD, AND BY WHAT SHE SAID PEOPLE LEARNED A LOT ABOUT HIM, BUT SHE SUFFERED A LOT TOO. SHE WAS SICK DIFFERENT TIMES, AND HAD VERY HARD TEMPTATIONS, BUT SHE STAYED FAITHFUL TO GOD. SHE DIED FROM A PAINFUL SICKNESS WHEN SHE WAS 41.


